ONLINE POSTINGS

MANDATORY SATURDAYS

Saturdays are presently scheduled for some of the weeks in November and December, operating schedules are posted and available on the GM Cami Assembly Website. **Please remember plans can change** but we are trying to encourage the company to be as transparent as we can so the membership can plan your schedules as well.

Just a reminder that Production members working the upcoming Mandatory Saturdays are permitted to Bank their time for those days. 8 hours worked can be banked for 12 hours of paid time off later. Maintenance continues the Sunday Bank Time program. In addition, MSO opportunities for members wanting to work additional overtime as coverage for another member is permitted, subject to usual guidelines of Letter 10 of the Collective Agreement.
