As a result of the loss of production from the current semi-conductor shortage, CAMI Assembly is exploring running production on a voluntary basis during the summer shutdown period. This survey is an application for team members to volunteer to work either 1 or 2 weeks of production during the weeks of July 5th & July 12th, 2021. This survey is to act as a confirmation for team members to work shutdown.

The deadline to submit this survey application is: **April 28, 2021**
Confirmation of production will be no later than June 30, 2021.

The following conditions will apply:

- 1) Voluntary work will be in lieu of vacation (vacation hours will be returned to vacation bank for rescheduling in the 2021-2022 calendar year).
- 2) All volunteers must sign up with the understanding it is a full week opportunity, including potential Saturday production.
- 3) Volunteers to sign up by their current team assignment

Sign up process:

- i. Sign up for both weeks on the survey or,
- ii. If only able to work one of the two weeks, please select the week you are interested in working

Additional information:

- 1) Both weeks are day shift operations only.
- 2) Team members may be scheduled to work on a different team and/or department that is not their current position during these 2 weeks.
- 3) Saturday production may be banked per current guidelines, if applicable.
- 4) The Company and the Union will establish a method of rescheduling vacation after the point in which vacation hours have returned to affected team member's vacation bank.
