Today, GM is announcing several semiconductor production adjustments at GM North American Assembly Plants, including confirmation that CAMI Assembly will ramp up to two (2) shifts of production beginning January 3, 2022.

This is exciting news as it brings over 600 team members back to work at CAMI Assembly. It also shows that GM is improving our supply of semiconductors. In January, all North American plants will be running at regular production, with no downtime due to semiconductors.
