CAMI Assembly Team:

As previously announced CAMI Assembly will cease production of the Chevrolet Equinox in April 2022 and construction and retooling will begin for the BrightDrop EV600 launch. Consequently, a temporary layoff for **Production** team members will commence effective **May 1, 2022** and for **Maintenance** team members effective **May 15, 2022**. Details follow:

- Production and Maintenance team members required to work during this layoff will be notified in writing
- All Powerhouse team members are excluded
- All full weeks of vacation currently scheduled during the temporary layoff period will remain
- Full weeks of vacation may be scheduled during the temporary layoff period (note: scheduling a vacation while on layoff does not re-start SUB/benefits)
- Full weeks of bank time and approved leaves of absence will remain unless cancelled by the team member
