Practice Good Hygiene

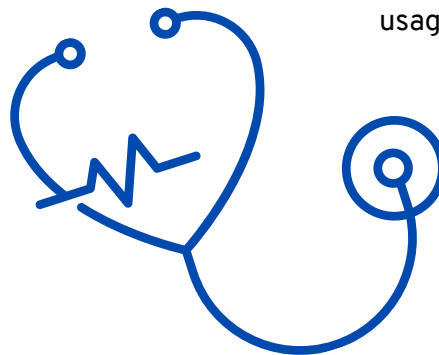
Wash hands regularly and utilize hand sanitizer and cleaning supplies made available to employees for optional use/cleaning.
