- When the election starts (12:01am, June 5<sup>th</sup>) members will automatically start to receive an email marked Unifor local 88 from simply voting ([vote@simplyvoting.com](mailto:vote@simplyvoting.com)). The same way you received it for the production vote in February.
- Emails submitted from the production vote as well as the retiree vote were used in the data submitted to Simply Voting. (they do not store it afterwards)
- Your email will include [**Elector ID**] (This is your GMIN # for production and for retirees it will employee #) and a unique [**Password**] assigned to that email address.
- The information provided to you will be used to sign in and access your ballots.
- Only 1 vote per elector is possible.
- **Please verify that your ballot is correct. If you notice any mistakes (We are human) or you think there is a mistake, please reach out BEFORE submitting your vote. Once your vote has been submitted, we cannot correct any mistakes.**
- **PLEASE CHECK ALL SPAM FOLDERS** if you do not see the email.

- Simply Voting can resend the email if needed.
- Members will be sent reminders throughout the election for those who have not voted yet.
- **Call/Email the elections committee if any help is needed.**
- All members were assigned a numerical grouping to indicate their voting segment, based on the election committee guidelines, bylaws, and employee lists provided by the company.
- Members will only vote based on the “Home” shift they are assigned to as of the cut off date of May 7, 2024.
- Once signed in, members will only see the positions they are able to vote for.
- Members do not have to vote for any/all positions. If left blank “Abstained” will appear on the voting receipt.
- For delegate positions, you do not need to vote for all. Vote only the candidates you want to see elected.
- If ballots are left blank the form will still submit, as all fields are optional.
- Once you have voted and clicked continue, please review your selections and click confirm and wait for the success screen. Once you see that screen you know your vote was submitted correctly.
