INGERSOLL - Unifor Local 88 members at General Motors CAMI have delivered an overwhelming strike mandate, authorizing their bargaining committee to take job action, if needed, to achieve a fair collective agreement with GM.

Strike Vote Results:

97 % In Favour

The current General Motors CAMI collective agreement expires at 10:59 p.m. on September 17, 2024.

The union will open formal negotiations with the automaker on Sept 09, 2024, in London, representing over 1200 auto workers covered by this collective agreement. This agreement is currently separate from the Unifor National agreement with GM that was bargained in Sept. 2023. Historically, Local 88 has always followed the pattern set by the Unifor Detroit 3 national bargaining teams.

Unifor is Canada's largest union in the private sector and represents 315,000 workers in every major area of the economy. The union advocates for all working people and their rights, fights for equality and social justice in Canada and abroad and strives to create progressive change for a better future.
