Responsibilities

- Sustain the business running without any downtime and ensure all active automated material delivery routes continue to run smoothly.
- Exchange units from active state to charge, maintenance or service, when required.
- Identify root cause of AME (Automated Mobile Equipment) faults and obstructions and drive root cause analysis and improvement.
- Become a subject matter expert in AME operations, including software interfaces (Ex. Seegrid Supervisor). Utilize live supplier software to identify problems and bottlenecks.
- Perform basic sensor calibration procedures when required.
- Collect and consolidate data (equipment errors or faults) to support plant leadership or manufacturing optimization directions/decisions.
- Train new operators in automation procedures, quick troubleshooting and standardized work involving AME interactions.
- Develop visual aids, pedestrian awareness content for operators to assist in any required day-to-day interaction with material automation technology.
- Communicate, coordinate, and facilitate MOC process for technology trials with team members, team leaders and group leaders.
- Identify improvement opportunities for active AME routes.
- Assist in Continuous Improvement workshops, benchmarking activities.
- Actively support and participate in the planning and execution of new automation project deployments in the facility led by the Manufacturing Optimization Team.
- Develop standardized work for AME operation and troubleshooting.
- Other duties as required.

Job Elements

- Proficiency with computer applications to monitor and maintain Seegrid operations, or ability to learn new applications.
- Able to learn the logic behind the operations of automated material delivery equipment.
- Experience using Microsoft Excel, Word and PowerPoint applications.
- Operation of mobile equipment.
- Strong written and oral communication skills.
- Experience driving continuous improvement.
- Ability to work collaboratively with other departments and resource groups.
- Can work as part of a team to achieve GM CAMI objectives.
- Understanding of the Management of Change process.
- Initiative to perform role without set schedule or cyclical tasks.
