Elbows up-gloves off: Defending Canada's Sovereignty from US aggression 4 sessions; Sept 11, 18, Oct 9, 16	What are the Trump administrations threats to economically destroy Canada, and absorb it into the US all about? Working Class Hero: The legacy of Buzz Hargrove 1 session; Oct 23	Basil 'Buzz' Hargrove started on the line in Windsor, and worked his way up to president of the Canadian Auto Workers Union (CAW). He passed away in 2025. What was his story and what can we learn from his life and leadership? **Registration for this course opens Sept 29, closes Oct 17
Movie and Discussion Night: Working in Auto Part 2 1 session; Nov 13	We will watch the historic documentary 'Loose Bolts' describing work on the line in the controversial Lordstown, Ohio GM plant in the 70's. Workers traded high wages for a rigid, de-humanizing system of quality control, boredom, anger, and turnover. Great way for newer hires and seasoned workers to compare our workplaces today. **Registration for this course opens Oct 20, closes Nov 7

The Occupational Health and Safety System at 50: Profits over Safety? 2 sessions; Nov 20 and 27	Workers fought long and hard to win a OHS system, and have made many important gains from it, especially since the 70's. However, do employers, and the system still put corporate profits over our health and safety? ** Registration for this course opens Oct 27, closes Nov 14
