SUSTAINABLE JOBS PARTNERSHIP COUNCIL

The **Sustainable Jobs Partnership Council** is an external advisory body made up of experts from key stakeholder and partner communities, including industry, trade unions, and indigenous organizations. It was convened to provide independent advice to the **Ministers of Energy & Natural Resources** and **Jobs & Families** on how to foster the creation of sustainable jobs, as well as measures to to support workers, communities, and regions in the context of a shift to a net-zero economy.

The Council is looking at its engagement plan over the next coming two months, ahead of its release of its first report to the minister in November. Recognizing the more immediate economic and trade impacts affecting many industries that are also implicated in the net-zero transition, the Council is looking to meet with workers, industry, Indigenous peoples, and other representatives in southwestern Ontario across the steel/aluminum, auto and forestry industries.

CAMI GM in Ingersoll, ON has been mentioned as a potential stop on this visit and the Sustainable Jobs Partnership Council would like the opportunity to meet with members from the plant to hear their perspectives.

We are looking for six volunteers to participate in a 1 hour discussion in October with targeted dates of October 20-21, 2025.
