The Unifor EV Auto Sector Upskilling Training Project is opening up applications to Unifor IPS members for a Facilities Maintenance Mechanic Certificate program.

What is the Program – The Facilities Maintenance Mechanic Certificate program is an in-person, instructor-led Certificate program. The Certificate was developed by St. Clair College, which is an accredited and recognized College. The Program course curriculum is attached.

Outlook – This training program will prepare a graduate to work in different fields of work, such as maintenance and/or janitorial in manufacturing and warehouse facilities, hospitals, school boards, government buildings, apartment and condominium buildings, as well as, entrepreneurial opportunities. Bringing a vast array of employment opportunities for a graduate of this program.

Length of Program – The program will begin on Wednesday, November 19, 2025 – June 14, 2026 (no classes on statutory holiday long weekends or 2-week December holiday break). Total program hours: 496.

Program Schedule and Location: Classes will be held in person at St. Clair College Windsor campus. Classes will be Saturday and Sunday (full days) and Wednesday evenings (4 hrs) a total of 20 hrs a week.

Cost – Tuition will be covered by the program. Each student will need to provide their own transportation.

Eligibility Requirements: Unifor IPS member, Grade 12/GED, Grade 12 English, Grade 10 Math, proficient in Microsoft Word.
