### ST. CLAIR COLLEGE – LIVE-ONLINE DELIVERY

The Unifor EV Auto Sector Upskilling Training Project is opening up applications to Unifor IPS members for a Certificate program that will be delivered by St. Clair College instructors through their Live-Online Portal. Both seating availability and the grants to cover tuition is limited.

- **What is the Program** – The Quality Assurance and Management Certificate + Program is a live instructor lead, online program. The Certificate program is a St. Clair College Board of Governors Certificate in the study of Quality Assurance and Management with additional EV battery and computer courses. The program was developed by St Clair College, an accredited and recognized college. The Program course curriculum is attached.
- **What is the Certificate program Schedule** - The courses will be held from 9 am to 1 pm from Monday to Friday (no classes on Statutory Holidays) for the duration from January 26, 2026 until June 26, 2026 approximately 20 hours a week for a total of 400 hours.
- **Where will the courses be held** – The first week of classes will be held in-person at Local 199 St. Catharines, ON. After the first week of classes the remaining program courses will be delivered through St Clair Colleges instructor led live-online portal.
- **Cost** – Tuition will be covered by the program. Each student will need to provide their own laptop/computer with a camera and secure, reliable internet. No textbooks will be required.
- **Eligible Requirement:** Unifor IPS member, Grade 12/GED, Basic Computer knowledge, access to a laptop/computer w/camera, built in microphone and reliable secure internet.
